



As we prepare to reopen our center and adapt to the restrictions of COVID 19, we would like to thank all our families for being so patient during this hard time. We also want to thank all frontline workers, who have been working hard to protect our community. We have made many adjustments to protect the health and safety for our children and staff. Please continue to be patient with us, as we adapt to a new setting.

We kindly ask all families to help us keep our facility COVID free by:

- Adults should wear a mask at all times, children are not required, but encouraged to wear a mask as well.
- Only staff and children will be allowed to enter the center, drop off/pick up will be at the front gate
- Pack all items inside a backpack/bag to help staff keep your child's items together
- Allow the same person to drop/pick up your child everyday
- Allow extra time for pick up and drop
- Read signs posted and letters sent home to help families teach children about being healthy and safe while at our center
- Remember our number one priority is to keep children and staff safe and healthy at all times

We will be reopening June 1st for essential workers. To help with cleaning and disinfecting, we will be open 7am-4pm, until further notice.. We will still provide meals, under the guidance of the department of public health.
